Program or requirements includes 404K GSF.

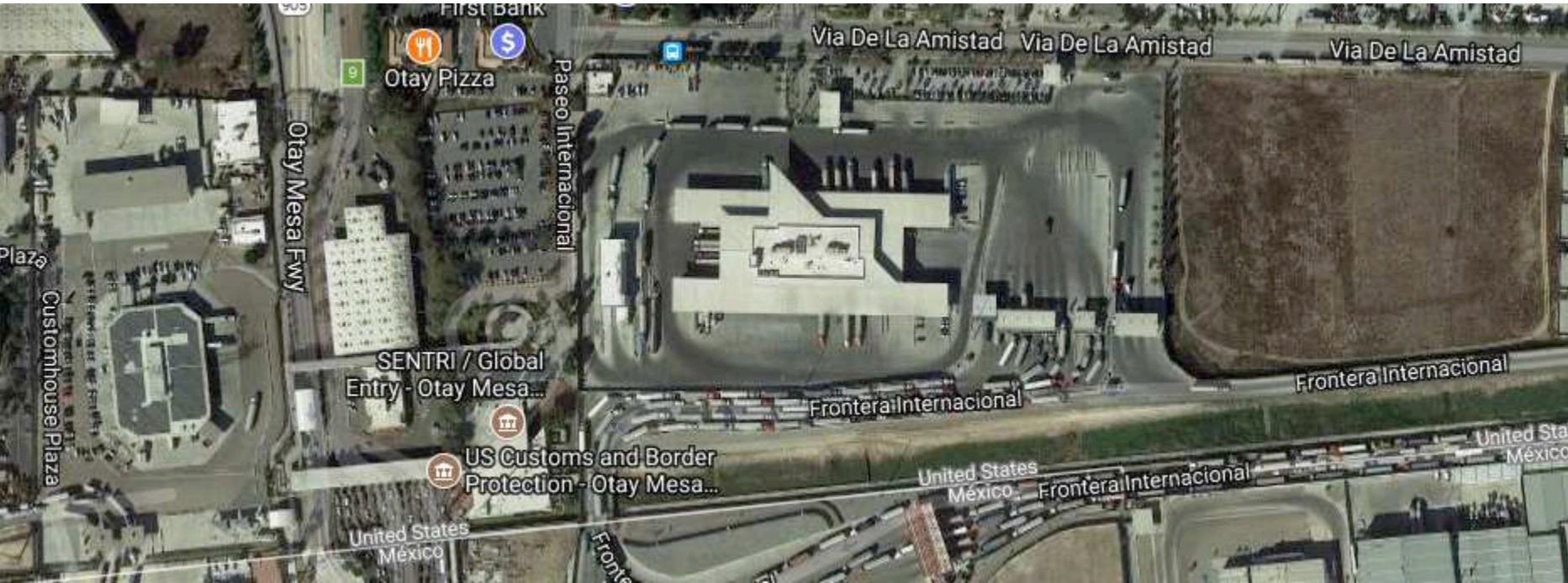
Removes the HazMat processing from the Export Lot

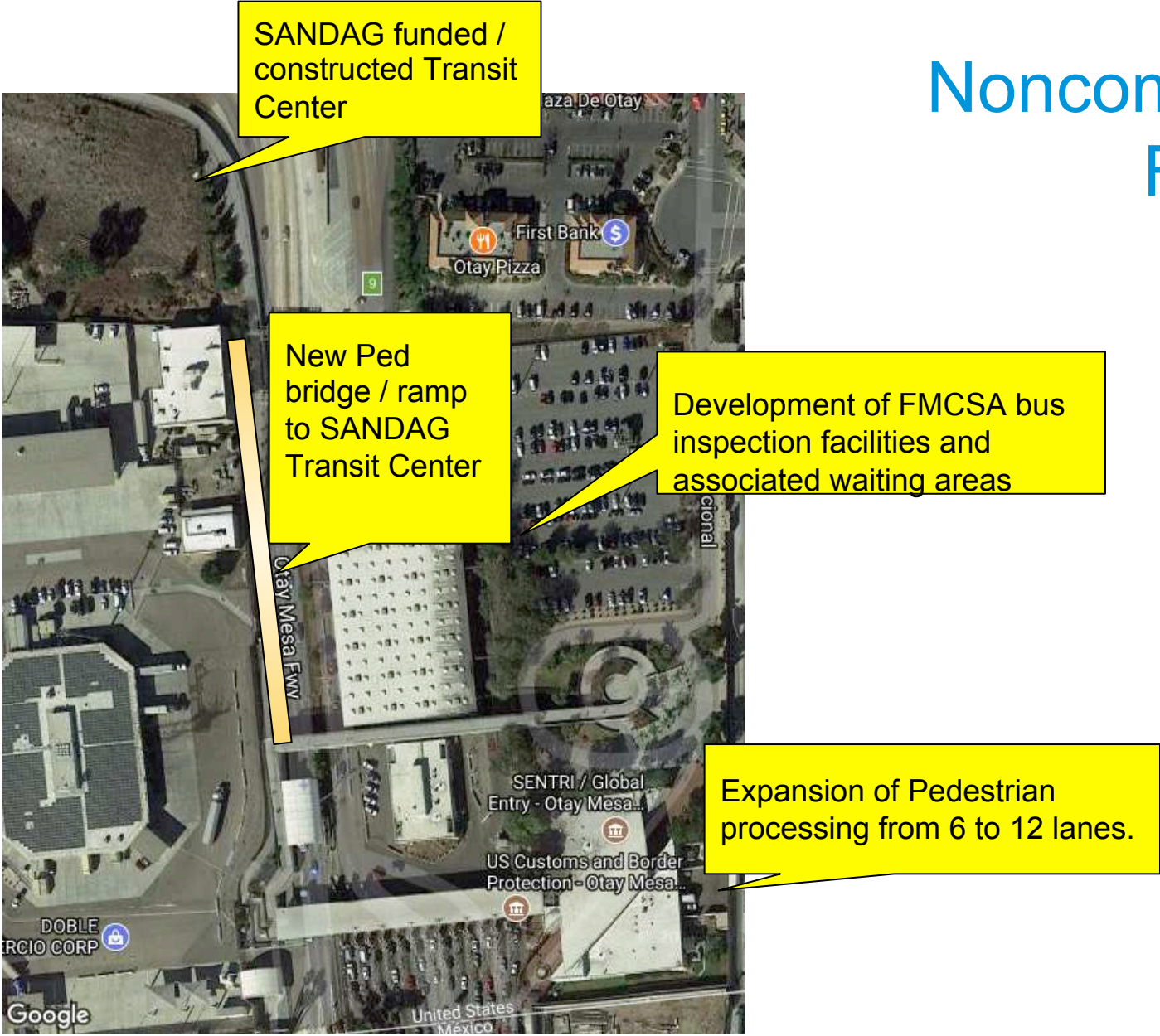

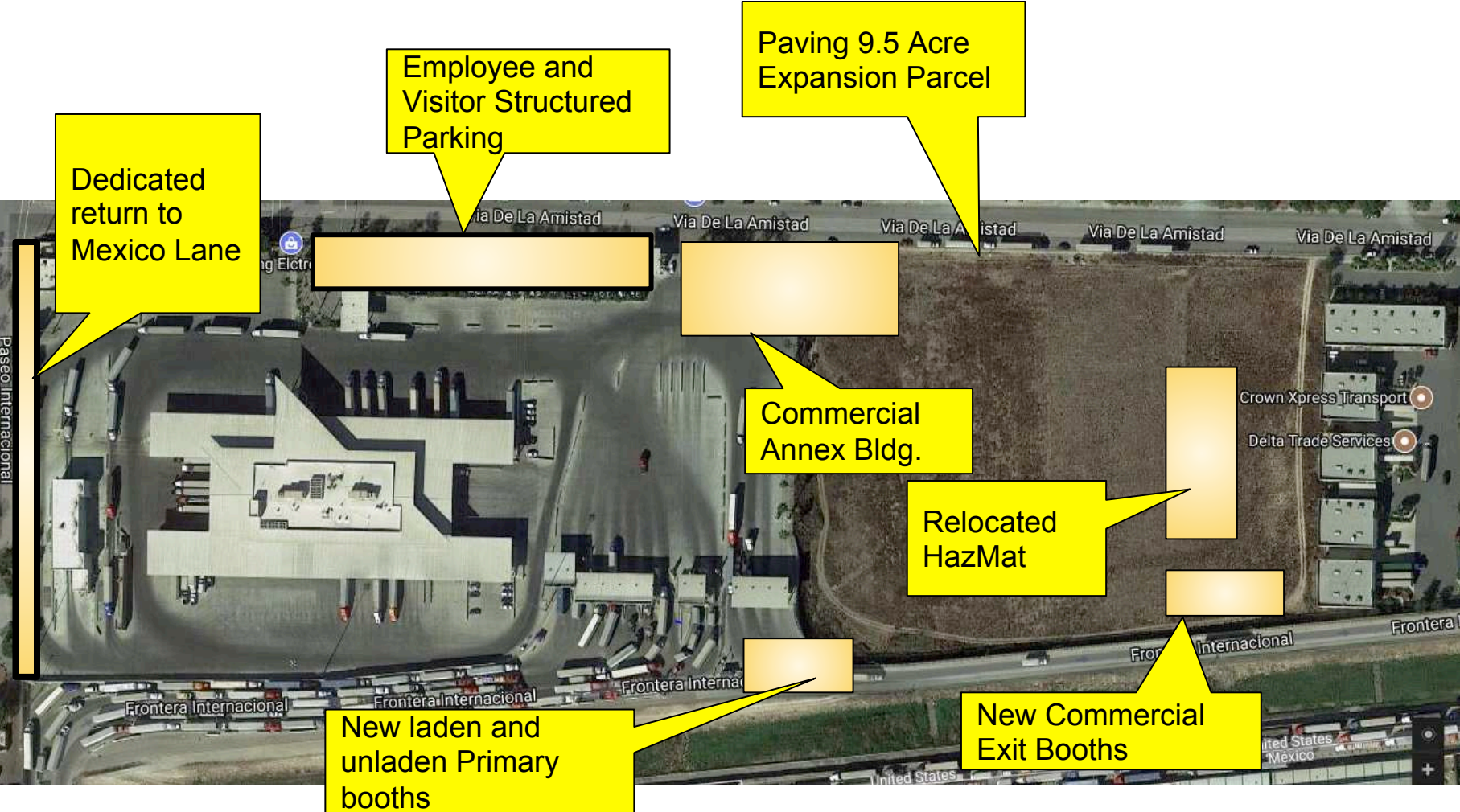
